Widespread Overland Flooding and Overflowing Water Experienced throughout Community

During the period of May 26 to June 23, 2011 the Municipality responded to widespread overland flooding, overflowing waterways and culverts throughout the Community. High soil moisture conditions caused by a very wet season during the fall of 2010, compounded by the 2010/11 winter/spring's largest on record snow packs and snow pillows plus the above normal precipitation in April/May 2011 provided ideal conditions that lead to extensive overland and stream flooding throughout the Crowsnest Pass. A state of local emergency was declared due to extreme infiltration of overland water for residents along 7th Avenue and 217th Street during June 17-23, 2011

The Municipality has made application for Disaster Recovery Assistance to the Province which will take several months to process. ***Should the Municipal application be approved by the Province*** community residents will then be notified through media advertising of a Registration Date to make their own application to the Province for damage incurred during this event. Residents who have experienced property damage are asked to document the costs and time required for repairs. In addition they will be required to contact their insurance company to obtain written confirmation that the property damage incurred is not insurable.

Alert on Long Grass and Weeds.

The weather this year has encouraged rapid growth for crops of Dandelions, Weeds and Grasses.

Bylaw # 704, 2006 states that a maximum height for grass is 12 inches. Dandelions and Weeds must be controlled or destroyed.

Property owners and tenants are responsible for Boulevards in front to the streets and from the yard in the back to the middle of the alleys. Please cut and control everything. Due to the volume of complaints and time restraints no warnings will be given. The first offence fine is \$ 250.00

No outside watering between the hours of
9am to 7pm

No outside watering on Monday

Special 21-day permits are available at no charge once per year only, for exceptions to this policy for newly seeded or sodded lawns or other extraordinary circumstances which would allow watering outside the restricted hours.
