### Snow Clearing - Sidewalks

The Municipality of Crowsnest Pass, Enforcement Services, wishes to remind all residents that the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass Traffic Bylaw requires residents to remove snow and ice from sidewalks adjoining their property within 48 hours. Residents are asked to not shovel snow onto municipal roadways.

#### BYLAW NO. 704, 2006 –Section 12 (6)

All persons owning or occupying premises in areas of the Municipality designated Commercial under the Municipal Land Use By-Law shall remove and clear away all snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions from the sidewalk situated on land adjoining the property owned or occupied by them within forty eight (48) hours of the time that such snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction was deposited thereon.

Violators will be ticketed and/ or towed.

### **Penalty Increase on Outstanding Property Taxes**

Starting in 2012 Bylaw #836, 2011 will come into effect, this bylaw provides for an increased penalty on unpaid taxes from **21% to 52.19%**.

### New Heavy Truck Bylaw

Council has recently passed the Heavy Truck Bylaw. This new bylaw will come into effect on January 31, 2012 and regulates truck traffic within the municipality.

Truck operators will no longer be able to park their trucks on residential streets or on residential driveways if the weight of the vehicle is over 5450 kg as of January 31, 2012.

Provincial violation tickets will be issued that are required to be paid to Provincial Courts. If you wish to plea not guilty you will have the option to attend court.

Enforcement Services will be pleased to answer your questions about the bylaw, and provide permitting if required. If truckers are concerned about their responsibilities within their commercial zoning requirements, Enforcement Services will be available to provide that information and provide copies of the Bylaw if required.
