

MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS

BY-LAW NO. 735, 2007

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 670, 2006, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE HANDLING, COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF ASHES, GARBAGE, REFUSE, AND OTHER WASTE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS.

THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS S FOLLOWS:

That the following sections be amended as follows:

Part 2 Definition

2.39 **“Waste Receptacle”** means a container which is not a commercial container and which is designed to facilitate the disposal of refuse. Said container shall hold a maximum of 84 litres and shall measure 30” X 37” or equivalent. Said container must be approved pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw for the disposal of refuse or any particular type of refuse.

Part 5 Municipal Collection and Removal of Refuse

- 5.2 (d) without limiting the foregoing, any discarded household chattel, material or equipment which has an overall weight of more than 25 kilograms or an overall length of more than 1.25 metres.
- 5.6 Bag size shall not exceed 30” X 37” or equivalent and the weight of the filled bag shall not exceed twenty-five (25) kilograms.
- 5.7 the bag limit may be waived by resolution of Council from time to time as deemed appropriate by Municipal Council.

Part 7 Refuse Receptacles, Weight of, Location and Refuse Enclosure

7.7 A collector shall not be required to remove any refuse receptacle which, together with its contents, exceeds twenty-five (25) kilograms.

Part 8 Preparation of Waste for Collection

- 8.2 The extra refuse referred to in clause 8.1(c) may include but is not limited to clippings from lawns, shrubs and trees on the premises from which the refuse is to be removed,- provided all refuse is bagged appropriately or placed in the appropriate receptacle.
- 8.4 Refuse not properly contained will not be collected.

This bylaw shall take effect on the date of final passing.
